and moved across the country to Vancouver. After a long awaited layoff, Nicole began to explore the spiritual aspects of yoga and pursue a life coaching certification.

"I realized how burnt out and unbalanced I was," says Nicole. "I'd neglected the other aspects of life like reading a book or visiting a best friend. I started making time for these things and in doing so, I also saw a whole world of other aspects of myself I never knew existed."

Nicole would spend the next 10 months traveling abroad with no set itinerary. Just her, a backpack and a yoga mat.

"I went from living a life of goals, objectives and strategies to living on a whim not knowing what I was going to do the next day. It was liberating," says Nicole. "For whatever reason I was given a very courageous soul," "When you remove yourself from everything that life keeps you busy doing there's a silence you can connect with."
