WASHINGTON, DC, USA, June 26, 2015 /EINPresswire.com/ -- The U.S. Supreme Court delivered a huge victory today for gay rights, ruling 5 to 4 that the Constitution requires that states can no longer allow marriage only for heterosexual couples, permitting samesex couples to marry no matter where they live.

Critics of the ruling, of which there are many, said the court has changed the traditional definition of marriage, sending the country into uncharted territory. Those favoring the ruling called it the most pressing civil rights issue of modern times.

Gay rights activist and best-selling author Timothy Kurek is encouraged by the ruling. "It's very exciting to see the country change its perspective, as I have changed mine," says Kurek, whose book "The Cross in the Closet" details how his opinion on the matter has changed dramatically since 2009.
