

Energy Efficient Window Manufacturer Outlines the Benefits of a True Passive House



"A passive house requires as little as ten percent of the energy used by typical buildings, which means an energy savings of up to ninety percent," Talalas says. "Passive Houses do not require heating and cooling systems on conventional scales, meaning that the money that would have gone towards larger heating and cooling systems can be spent instead on better windows, thicker insulation and a ventilation system, which are the essential hallmarks of a passive house design."

According to Talalas, a passive house design is a good

investment, both for the owner's wallet and for the global climate as well.

Passive Houses Offer Affordability

"Passive Houses not only save money over the long term, especially in light of rising energy costs, but are surprisingly affordable to begin with," Talalas notes. "The investment in higher quality building components is mitigated by the elimination of expensive heating and cooling systems."

He says that while passive houses may cost more upfront, than their conventional counterparts, the long term savings are incredible, particularly when financial incentives and long term energy savings are factored in.

"Passive Houses may be known for their drastically lower energy use and associated energy costs, but it is the level of comfort they offer that homeowners appreciate the most," Talalas says. "A well insulated building envelope, triple glazed energy-efficient windows and insulated frames maintain desired temperatures."

The systems used to help create a truly comfortable passive home and the quality ventilation that a passive home offers will also prevent moisture build up, putting a stop to both the condensation that commonly forms along window frames and prevent mold growth.
