

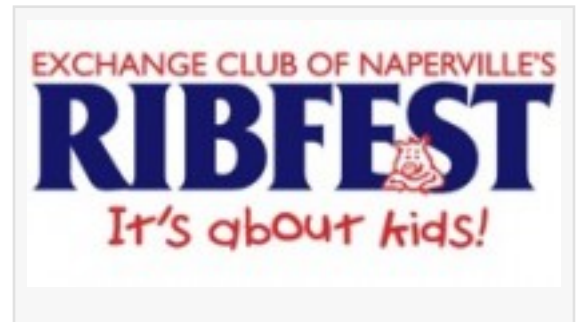
# Ribfest Celebrates Fiesta Latina
