"SkyRise can meet a number of different exhibiting needs. It's a modular system that can be completely reconfigured to change shape or size to meet the footprint requirements of different events at no additional cost. The wall panels are applied to the frame with heavy-duty magnets, so there's no need for tools," said Sofia Troutman, Customer Engagement and Industry Relations Manager at Skyline Exhibits ([www.skyline.com](http://www.skyline.com)).

Sturdy aluminum framing makes up the skeleton of SkyRise™. To clad that framing, exhibitors have their choice of semi-rigid panels, frosted panels, or custom-designed fabric graphics. Thanks to the magnets, panels can be changed out without having to take down the framing. A lockable wooden door can be added to the exhibit, creating a secure area for storage or for use as a private conference area.

Four standard frame sizes are available for SkyRise™: 2'x4', 4' x4', 2' x 8' and 4' x 8' but custom-sizes can be ordered. With 8' tall frames available the system is specifically designed for larger, taller [custom trade show exhibits](#). SkyRise™ integrates to other Skyline exhibit systems like SkyTruss™, Envoy™, Engage™, Tapestry™, and Tube Ultra™. A variety of accessories are available for SkyRise™ for added functionality.

"SkyRise can reduce costs in a couple of different ways. The adjustable design saves exhibitors money over having to buy new pieces or entire new exhibits whenever they want to change their look. But the most significant cost-savings comes in the form of labor costs. Since no tools are required to assemble the exhibit, there's no need to hire specialized laborers and the time to full assembly is reduced. A 10-foot conference room can be set up in 30 minutes by just one person," explained Troutman.

SkyRise™ is the latest exhibiting system from Skyline Exhibits that attempts to make exhibiting easier and less costly. The company is known for new and innovative trade show ideas that are used throughout the world. One such example is WindScape™, the world's first air-powered exhibit system.

Skyline will be adding new features to SkyRise later this year.
