The purpose of the BSA is to prevent banks from becoming unknowing intermediaries in illicit activity.

Stachowitz joined [SNB](#) in May of 2007 as a Personal Banker. In 2014 he was elected Retail Credit and Compliance Officer. He is a 2007 graduate of Morningside College where he received his BS Degree in Business Administration. Additionally, he has attended the Iowa Bankers Association's (IBA) Compliance School in 2012 and the IBA's Bank Secrecy Act Compliance School in 2013.
