


Universal and pervasive in its implications, Creativity: Revealing the Truth about Human Nature demonstrates five cardinal, but generally overlooked, principles of human existence:


- First, the inherence of creativity in human nature and, therefore, its universal distribution.
- Second, the naturalness of creativity: a quality or ability that is inherent in the person by virtue of natural law, and that therefore cannot be taken away or denied; "a direct prerogative from the Infinite Will and Consciousness" that therefore is inviolable; a right that is not contingent upon tradition, belief, culture, government, or custom.
- Third, the centrality of creativity in human life, i.e., its primacy among the forces that drive human behavior and shape people's lives.
- Fourth, actualization of one's creative potential as the primary goal of life; "the healthiest and highest expression of human nature"; and "the optimal state of being."

• Fifth and finally, inadequate opportunity for the vast majority of people to reach their creative potential, or to fulfill their authentic purposes in life, as the root of the global epidemic of meaninglessness and the resultant social and psychological problems that are ruining the lives and destinies of countless millions of people around the world, traumatizing families and national societies.

The crux of Revealing the Truth about Human Nature and stated reasons for its writing are three and related: First, to return mankind to the proper understanding of its inherently creative essence - Homo Creativus - an understanding of human nature that is crucial to successful parenting, education, management, governance, care-giving, and more.
