AVM is usually congenital and currently not much information is available on the genetic transmission patterns of AVM. According to FMI's research, the arteriovenous segment of the Gamma Knife market is expected to amplify at a CAGR of 7.6% during the period 2015-2025.

Use of Gamma Knife in treating Trigemial neuralgia, also known as prosopalgia, is also gaining acceptability in the healthcare sector. According to FMI, this segment of Gamma Knife market is projected to expand at a CAGR of 7% during the forecast period and reach a valuation of US\$ 32.9 Mn by 2025.
