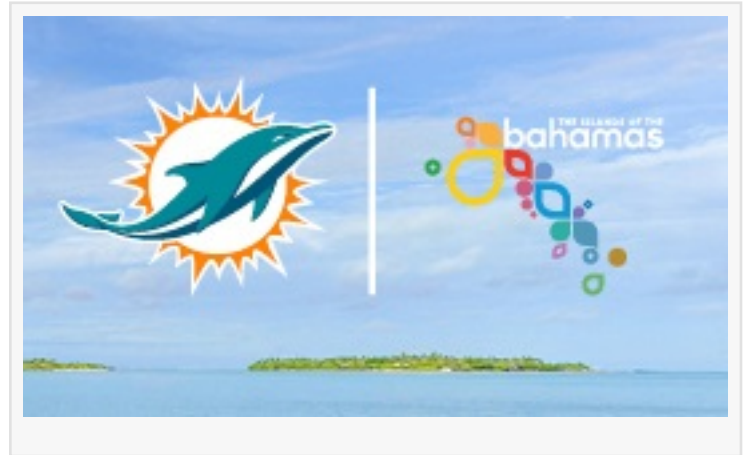


Bahamas launches special Dol-fans: “Mom and Me, Bahamas Slumber Party” package
