


Oral Herpes Virus Can Attack the Voice Box; The CBCD Reviews a Study


Herpes infections of the larynx (voice box) can be easily misdiagnosed. (1)

The meta-analysis showed that oral antiviral therapy decreases the duration and the associated pain of an outbreak by merely one day."
