Avid Life Media will be led by the "existing senior management team" until a new CEO is chosen, the company said.

A hacker or group of hackers known as the Impact Team claimed responsibility for the security breach last week. They exposed the email addresses, names, and other information

from millions of users of the site, which claims to connect people who are looking to have affairs. The company is currently facing at least five lawsuits seeking class-action status and more than a half-billion dollars.

"We are actively adjusting to the attack on our business and members' privacy by criminals," Avid Life Media wrote. "We will continue to provide access to our unique platforms for our worldwide members."
