About the Series

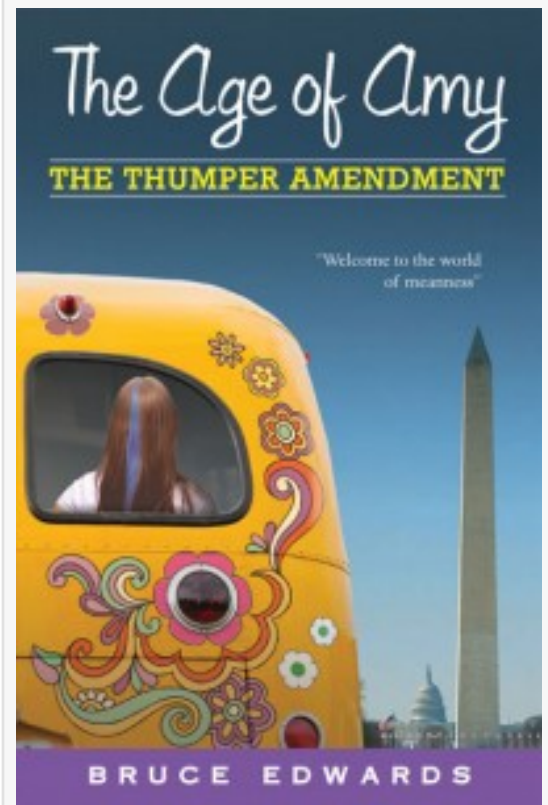
