Anyone who sells hardwood flooring should be able to tell you how to maintain it and how to repair it." *Ron Anders* Moisture is one of the worst culprits for damage to a wood floor. Homeowners should ensure that door mats are in use and a location has been created for wet boots and clothing so that it doesn't drip on the floors. They should also be proactive in cleaning up spills as quickly as possible before the stain sets in.

Another concern for hardwood floors is scratches and dents. If people are dressed up for a formal occasion, they

may wear high heels, which can create small dents in the floor. Scratches may occur if people slide their chairs. Place pads under the furniture or attach rubber covers to the legs of the chairs to help prevent scratches.

As careful as a homeowner can be, not all spills and scratches can be prevented, especially if they like to entertain. The Hardwood Flooring Store wants homeowners to know that many of these problems can be easily repaired by sanding and staining. Slight indentations and scratches will only require a light sanding. It is also important to sand the area of a floor that has had a spill resulting in discoloration before re-staining.

"If you aren't sure what to do with your floor damage, talk to a flooring professional," says Ron Ander of The Hardwood Flooring Store, a <u>hardwood flooring company in Toronto</u>. "Anyone who sells hardwood flooring should be able to tell you how to maintain it and how to repair it."

Ander advises making a consultation the first step in your floor repair to prevent further damage. Using the wrong products or repair methods can make the problem worse instead of

fixing it. In many cases, homeowners can make the small repairs themselves, but they should hire a professional for bigger issues or if they don't feel confident in their abilities.
