



Disabled Veteran Receives Kohler Generator through CenterPoint Energy's Power a Hero Program

A disabled veteran in the greater Houston area has been awarded an automatic residential standby generator from Kohler Generators.

Depending upon specific needs, a standby generator can power critical and sophisticated appliances and systems, including lights, heating/cooling systems, refrigerators, sump pumps, security systems and more.
