

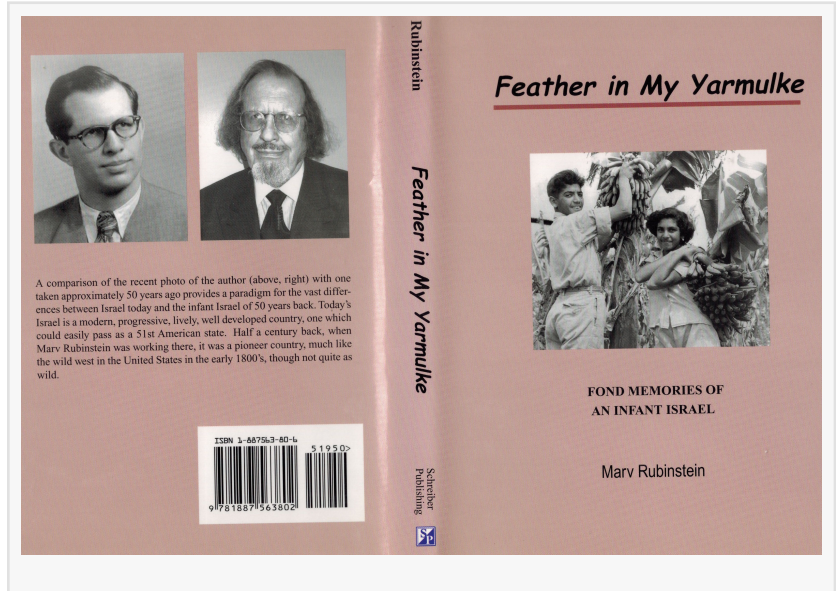
FEATHER IN MY YARMULKE
