• You can also scrub your toilet clean after adding half a cup of Borax to the toilet bowl with a squirt of lemon juice right on top of it.

• If you're cooking lots of tasty treats for your guests your chopping board may have more stains than you'd like! Rub the board with lemon juice, leave a couple of hours then rinse.

• After all that running around cooking and getting your house clean, and getting sweaty, you'll want to get rid of those underarm stains from your clothes – pour some lemon juice on them, add some salt, then rub and rinse.
