

Lesbians May be at Greater Risk for HPV Infections; The CBCD Reviews the Medical Evidence

Compared to heterosexual women, lesbians are at greater risk for HPV and cervical cancer due to health and lifestyle factors. (1)

The National LGBT (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender) Cancer Network says that “genital HPV is transmitted by skin to skin contact. It's risk is present, therefore, in all LGBT people who engage in sex.” (1) When it comes to lesbians, “women who have sex with women can contract the virus from an infected partner in the same ways heterosexual women can, including through genital to genital contact, touching the genitals of a partner and then one's own, or sharing sex toys without cleaning them properly first.” (1)

Moreover, according to Fox News, lesbians don't get screened for HPV infection as often as heterosexual women. (2) University of Washington researchers said this is “due partly to doctors' sometimes incorrect assumptions about their sexual history ... that is because the disease is most commonly transmitted during heterosexual sex and doctors may wrongly assume lesbians have only had

sex with other women, despite studies that have found most lesbians and their partners have had sex with men.” (2)

These procedures use liquid nitrogen, a surgical knife (scalpel), a carbon dioxide (CO2) laser, or electrical current to remove the abnormal growths caused by the HPV. These growths include cells that harbor the active virus. The procedures do not target cells with the latent virus. Since they do not remove the latent virus, these procedures only produce a temporary remission.” (3) In contrast, the formula of Novirin was designed to target the latent HPV.
