We've dispelled the myths a million times, but they just keep coming back." He underscores, "People ask why our industry needs the RFS, and I can tell you why: because – without the RFS - oil has 100 percent market share, and consumers don't have a choice at the pump."

Likis remarks, "It's my job as consumers' go-to source for truth-based automotive information to deliver the facts to you, so you can make best-of-decisions. Neil Koehler will tell it like it is regarding the RFS."
