

Does a Cold Sore Mean You Have Herpes?; The CBCD Answers a Survey Question



The Center for the Biology of Chronic Disease (CBCD)'s November 2015 survey found that 37% of participants had the false belief that they were not infected with the herpes virus even if they got cold sores from time to time. When an individual does experience symptoms, depending on the strain of herpes with which he or she is infected, that person can develop cold sores (usually due to HSV-1) or genital herpes





(usually due to HSV-2). The CDC notes that when the genital herpes virus causes symptoms, an individual usually experiences "one or more blisters on or around the genitals, rectum or mouth. The blisters break and leave painful sores that may take weeks to heal. These symptoms are sometimes called "having an outbreak." The first time someone has an outbreak they may also have flu-like

symptoms such as fever, body aches, or swollen glands. Repeat outbreaks of genital herpes are common, especially during the first year after infection. Repeat outbreaks are The Center for the Biology of Chronic Disease (CBCD) recommends that anyone diagnosed with a herpes infection take Gene-Eden-VIR or Novirin. The meta-analysis showed that oral antiviral therapy decreases the duration and the associated pain of an outbreak by merely one day."
