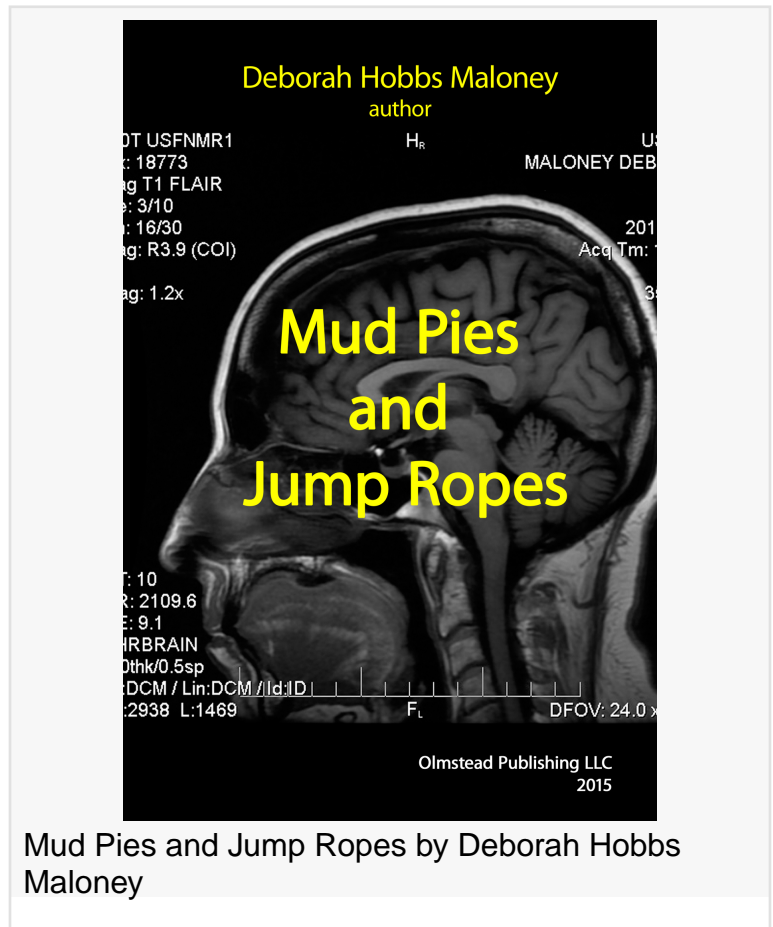
operation. I seriously couldn't believe that after 45 years of suffering that there may be a future for me.”

Fernando Vale, MD performed the intricate surgery at Tampa General Hospital that changed Maloney's life. The selective anterior mesial temporal lobe resection of the hippocampus/amygdala made all the difference in her life.

Maloney is now motivated to educate those with both physical and mental limitations how she overcame her problem. She hopes that by sharing her story, others will see that there is always hope.
