

U.K. Begins to Offer the HPV Vaccine to Gay Men; the CBCD Reviews a Report

Health Minister Mark Drakeford said that "A cancer vaccination is to be offered to gay men under the age of 45." (1)



The United Kingdom has begun offering the HPV vaccine to gay men to help protect against certain HPV caused cancers, which are seen more commonly in this community. (1) According to BBC News, "Expert advice has said vaccination can offer protection against other types of cancer commonly seen in gay men. An advisory committee also recommended it for sex workers and people who are HIV positive, but is still considering its merits for adolescent boys." (1)

You also can develop symptoms years after you have sex with someone who is infected making it hard to know when you first became infected." (4)
