

Herpes Infection and Eating Peanuts; The CBCD Explores a Link



Older studies showed that foods, which contain the amino acid arginine, such as peanuts, may cause herpes outbreaks. These studies claimed that the herpes virus needs "this amino acid for growth, replication and to become active." (1) Healthline.com notes that, "a cup of peanuts contains 4.6 grams of arginine." (2)

However, more recent studies disagree.

In a Japanese study from 2009, Dr. Naito and colleagues wrote that "Arginine suppressed the growth of HSV-1 concentration-dependently." (3) Specifically, the arginine does not cause herpes outbreaks as originally thought. Instead, it may actually kill the herpes virus, if it is consumed within the very first hours of viral reactivation.
