

Penis Enlargement Techniques May Increase Risk of Genital Warts; The CBCD Reviews a Report


Patients who wear penis-stretching devices can develop abrasions that can facilitate the spread of sexually transmitted diseases like genital warts. (1)

Men may increase the risk of developing genital warts, which are caused by the human papillomavirus (HPV), if they use certain penis enlargement techniques. "Genital warts usually appear as a small bump or group of bumps in the genital area. They can be small or large, raised or flat, or shaped like a cauliflower." (2)
