

Saudia Los Angeles new offices inaugurated

Saudia flies three times a week to and from Los Angeles, which will be increased to five flights weekly by June of this year. It operates the latest B777-300 with flatbed seats in First Class and the latest in in-flight entertainment along with world-class in-flight cuisine.
