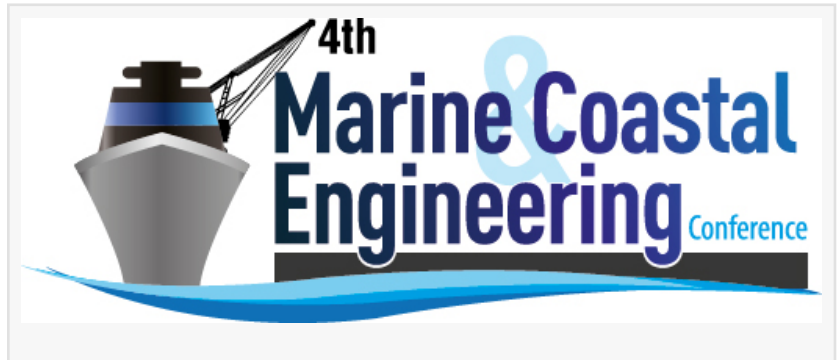


AECOM, ZADCO, DHI to discuss marine and coastal engineering this year
