

Studies Show that Green Tea Works against HPV



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pharmacological properties, including antiviral, anti-infective, and immunostimulatory properties ... catechins have been shown to have antiproliferative properties in various cell lines and may have direct virucidal (virus killing) effect." (3)

The CBCD therefore recommends that HPV infected individuals take Gene-Eden-VIR or Novirin. These natural antiviral products have a patented formula, which includes formula was found to reduce <u>HPV symptoms</u> in two separate post-marketing clinical studies that followed FDA guidelines. (4)
