team selection has seen a huge increase in popularity during the 2015/16 season, but it is the podcast recorded by the website owners that is really enjoying meteoric success and praise.

The [Fantasy Football Podcast](#) features the website creator who goes by the guise of Mills as the host of the show, with Quigliano playing the role of football expert and regular guest of the show JP often being portrayed as the village idiot. The blend of football knowledge, review and predictions with a good old dollop of British humor seems to have struck a chord with listeners all over the world.

25% of the show's listeners are based in the United States with a further 28% being based in Australia and New Zealand. 35% of the listenership is made up European listeners with the remainder listening from Asia, South America and Africa. The truly global Premier League following has been replicated by this [Premier League Podcast](#) of such small beginnings. Website owner Jason Mills stated 'we started the podcast for

a bit of a laugh, but when we found out that people actually wanted to listen we started to take it a little bit more seriously'. The Birmingham based football mad pundit went on to say 'even though we now achieve in excess of 10,000 listeners per month we still try and stay true to what made the show a success in the first place. That's banter with a group of mates who love talking football'.

They certainly seem to have got the mixture right for a show that attracts listeners from 6 continents to tune in to the 25 minute show. The show itself is found on iTunes, their own website and YouTube and so far takes the form of an audio only podcast. Due to the popularity of the show, there is now a premium version of the show that gives listeners that little bit extra. The show co-host Quigliano said 'the fans wanted that little bit more so we introduced a 5-10 minute add on for those super-fans who were prepared to pay a little for even more Fantasy Premier League advice and banter'.

The premium membership costs less than \$20 a year and has been a hit amongst many of the show's fans. The membership also gives these fans access to extra content on the website.

The Fantasy Premier League based site is just about to complete it's first full season and shows no signs of stopping any time soon. With a growing fan base and a fanatical podcast following, this group of 'pals' from the UK could be about to become soccer's next big thing.
