

Scientists Recognize Link Between Herpes Virus and Alzheimer's Disease

31 specialists pen an editorial in the Journal of Alzheimer's Disease.


The oral herpes virus may cause Alzheimer's Disease, according to a worldwide team of senior scientists. This group is comprised of 31 specialists from Oxford, Edinburgh, Manchester, and Cambridge universities, as well as Imperial College, wrote an editorial that suggested herpes (and other pathogens) as a cause of Alzheimer's Disease. (1) The authors of the editorial named three main candidates for the cause of the disease. These included the herpes simplex virus 1 (HSV-1), a type of corkscrew-shaped bacteria called spirochaete, and the chlamydia bacteria. (1) The editorial was published in the Journal of Alzheimer's Disease.

“We are saying there is incontrovertible evidence that Alzheimer's Disease has a dormant microbial component. We can't keep ignoring all of the evidence.” - Professor Douglas Kell of the University of Manchester's School of Chemistry (1)

“The authors say that viruses and bacteria are common in the brains of elderly people, and although they are usually dormant, they can ‘wake up’ after stress or if the immune system is compromised.

Around two thirds of people will acquire the herpes virus at some point in their lives, and many will not realise they have it.” (1) The Center for the Biology of Chronic Disease (CBCD)

The meta-analysis showed that oral antiviral therapy decreases the duration and the associated pain of an outbreak by merely one day."
