"Many of these clothing pieces and other items have only been worn once, and many were never worn at all and still have the original tag," said Ed Nadeau of Nadeau's Auction Gallery. "This promises to be an exceptional auction, with a depth of couture and high-end, ready-to-wear that is seldom seen. It's also an exciting glimpse into the closet of an elite, <u>fashion</u>-minded socialite."

The identity of the socialite has not been revealed, at the request of her estate. However, the names of the designers whose labels this dedicated fashionista bought and wore are no secret. "These are just a few of the gorgeous offerings that will be sold May 14th," Mr. Nadeau said.

Previews are scheduled for Thursday, May 5th, from 4-6:30 pm; Friday, May 6th, from 3-5 pm; Thursday, May 12th, from 12 noon to 6:30 pm; Friday, May 13th, from 12 noon to 5 pm; and Saturday, May 14th, the date of auction, from 8:30 am until the first gavel falls at 10 am Eastern time; or by appointment. "I suggest coming to the earlier preview dates," Mr. Nadeau suggested. "The later dates are expected to be extremely busy. Also, limited fitting rooms will be available."
