with great personalities mixed with proficiencies at their instruments which goes far beyond the norm. Sitting here, knowing that this was Jason Bozec's first gig with the band - and knowing too that he had not previously even rehearsed the BonJovi set - well, my god - I am completely blown away by this performance. I brought my wife with me, and at 50-something - we're not ever out this late, ever! She and I stayed to the second last song of the last set - and thoroughly enjoyed ourselves...I'm not sure exactly how much money we spent, but when I got home I did notice that my pockets were not overly flowing with cash! And, I have to tell you - it was money well spent."
