May 2016, Dubai - Dubai Sky Clinic, one the UAE's leading and longest established dental clinics, introduces its innovative laser gum surgery techniques, including gum depigmentation, under the direction of Dr Yasmin Omran, a dental surgeon with specialized training in laser surgery. Laser gum surgery is a laser-based technique for the treatment of periodontal disease using a specialized dental laser. Laser therapy is an amazing breakthrough in the treatment of periodontal disease, which replaces cutting the gum tissue with a scalpel and does not require stitches. This means an easier recovery with minimal bleeding, which preserves gum tissue and reduces root exposure and sensitivity.

Dr Yasmin said: "Laser gum surgery allows us to remove harmful bacteria and diseased tissue from the gum pocket by passing a laser light between the gum and tooth. The treatment is almost entirely painless, but we use local anaesthetic to eliminate any possible discomfort and insert a tiny laser fibre (about the thickness of three human hairs) between the tooth and gum and the infection is cleared away by removing only the diseased tissue. This can be done without making any type of incision. After removing the diseased tissue, the laser immediately cauterizes the wound. The result is that you experience little to no bleeding. An added benefit of the laser is its ability to seal the nerve endings. The entire process results in only minor discomfort afterward."

Dubai Sky Clinics is one of the few dental clinics in the region to utilise lasers for gum surgery under the supervision of an oral surgeon specifically trained in laser surgery.

Dr Yasmin emphasises that gum whitening or depigmentation has to be done in the right hands otherwise patients risk getting burns and long-term problems.

From a cosmetic point of view, discolouration on the gum do not usually cause serious problems, but they can be unsightly and cause self-consciousness when smiling. Genetics, smoking and certain medications can all cause gum pigmentation. The problem with gum spots is that they can make healthy gums falsely appear unhealthy. The gums are often just as visible as the teeth; therefore the appearance of healthy gums is just as important as healthy teeth are to a great smile. Luckily with dental laser treatment, these spots can be removed quickly and painlessly - with amazingly fast

healing time.

Dr Yasmin added: "A lot of people want to give their smile a 'lift' and they assume the only way to do this is with extensive veneers. This is not the case. I like the give people the best natural smile they can have, which means exploring a range of options. Many people don't realise that what they need is not veneers, but rather gum contouring or gum depigmentation to brighten up their smile and give them an overall 'boost', so the whole mouth looks more aesthetically pleasing."

Dr Maximillian Riewer, founder of Dubai Sky Clinic, said: "We are constantly seeking ways to become more innovative and to offer our patients access to the latest dental techniques the minute they are launched globally.
