Walker explains how terrorism will eventually take on a more insidious focus – biological warfare and the widespread disruption of electronic networks – including banking. He sees an escalation in prophetic events and points to the destabilization of every country around Israel. Walker says Saudi Arabia and Egypt are linchpins for the future – targets for overthrow by ISIS. He predicts ISIS will bring down Hamas in Gaza and the West Bank, placing Israel at ever greater risk. He also points out the involvement of Russia in Syria – a

move that puts troops on the Israel's northern border.

"According to a handful of experts on the history and Mid-East affairs, the real story is much bigger than a humanitarian catastrophe that is unfolding. I served over the largest Messianic congregation in the United States, speak and write on trends related to Jews, Israel, and prophecy. I believe the disbursement of ISIS and the expansion of Muslim colonization in Europe are opening the door for the downfall of western free governments – eventually," shares Walker about the inspiration behind his book.

"The story points to social data that shows Muslim population in a given country exceeds eight percent as it reaches its tipping point. This is when terrorist activities increase and disrupt social order

and creating chaos. Western countries that value freedom of press and thought are vulnerable by virtue of their openness and collective charity. Rather than amalgamate, many Muslims are creating their own communities, laws, and pushing their values on their hosts.
