


First Of Its Kind In Arizona: Lip Sync Battle To Raise Funds For Leukemia & Lymphoma Society

The Lip Sync Battle will be the culmination of a 10-week fundraising drive by One Team for Humanity, the team for Wayne Warrington 2016 MWOY nominee in Arizona.

"Most people aren't aware of how prevalent leukemia and lymphoma are in our country and how many lives are affected. We are promoting this dynamic fund raising event for one amazing evening. It is our privilege to work with this great organization and bring to light how our community can help this cause."

Tickets for the Lip Sync Battle are \$21 for general admission, or \$42 for VIP access, which includes red carpet photos and two complimentary drinks. Proceeds from the event will be donated to the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society of Arizona, a 501(c)(3) organization.
