JULY 7: SWING 7 plays all types of music including: Swing, Jazz, Latin, and R&B. WINERY: Vermeil Wines.

JULY 14: WILD CATAHOULAS is a unique Cajun/ Zydeco band in the North Bay that merges traditional Cajun French two-steps and waltzes. WINERY: August Briggs Winery.

JULY 21: TWICE AS GOOD showcases Paul and Rich Steward, father-and-son, Native American, ultimate Blues Duo! WINERY: Huge Bear Wines.
