Daphne, now a graduate of Global Leadership Academy (GLA), and enrolled in University, is leading the way to bring light on a dark continent. And there are more Daphnes in the shacks and the homes around us.

Everyone remembers that one teacher who made a difference in their lives while they went to school. GLA's teachers, administrators, counselors and staff members work tirelessly to stir interest and passion in these less fortunate kid's heart. Global Leadership Academy is intentional about personal development in the discovery process of education. Values like responsibility, integrity, honesty, respect, and trust are celebrated in and out of the classroom. The school's vision is to reach the potential, the dream inside of the students and call it out, believe in them, and affirm them as they go out to impact the nations.

Since the first class of 2012, GLA has had a 100% graduation rate each year (the regional average is 62%). Those that have a 100% graduation rate are only 6% of the high schools in South Africa. The cost for a scholarship is approximately \$83 per month or \$1,000 per year, which includes tuition, school meals, uniforms, books and lab fees.
