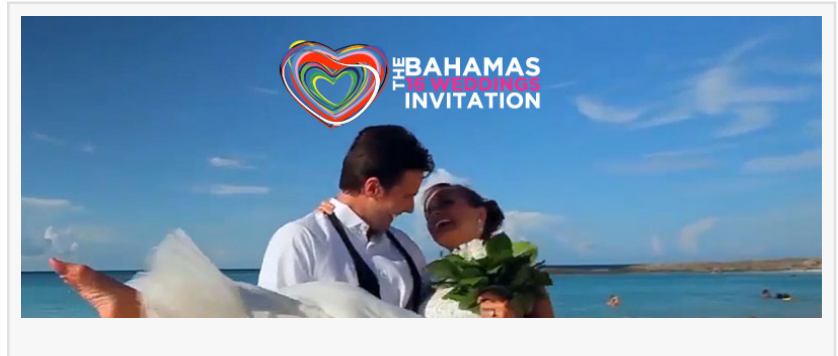


Sixteen lucky Canadian couples chosen to wed in The Bahamas
