

Texas Mystery Writer Publishes New Murder Mystery Novel - T-Head Dead


When the county DA is found dead out at the end of a Corpus Christi fishing pier, Police Detective, Jesse Ramos is brought into solve the murder.

He is a member of the Western Writers of America and has been on panel discussions about frontier gambling. Recently, he appeared on a television documentary about the Royal Gorge War.




