Independence Day: Resurgence Release Renews Discussion on Potential for Alien Invasion

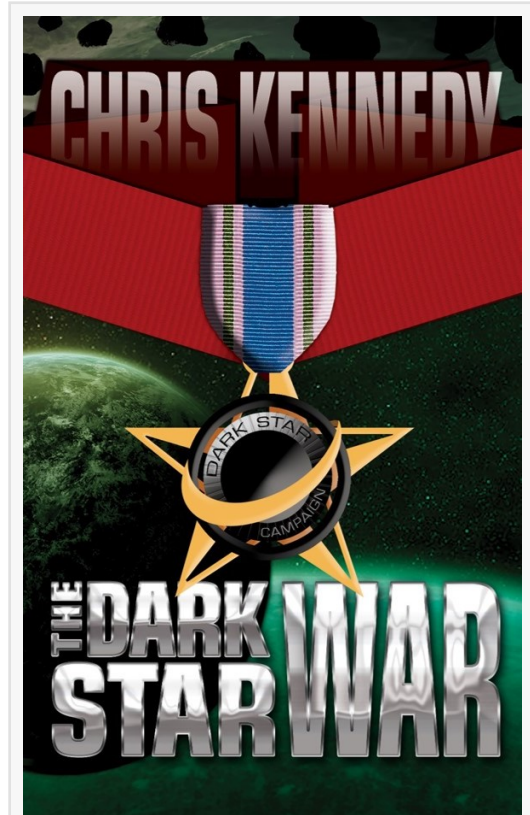

“Although exposure to alien technology is likely to help us make great advances, there is also a great deal of risk in trying to incorporate too much too fast,” Kennedy added. “Just like in Independence Day, though, we may not have a lot of choice. If we were faced with a hostile alien invasion, we would have to use every means at our disposal to survive, and even that might not be enough.
