VIP tickets run \$100 and include limo service, champagne, VIP seating, free gourmet tastings in the restaurant pavilion (11:30am-4:30pm), three complimentary drink tickets, and a commemorative gift. Please note that 100% of ALL proceeds benefit Randall Children's Hospital and Providence Cancer Center. Free parking and shuttle service is provided for all guests at MHCC. For a \$1 donation, downtown Portland & Westside ticket holders can catch one of the Cascadia Cruiser "Soul Buses" every 30 minutes (11am-9pm) from the Lloyd Center parking lot and will in turn receive a complimentary cold beer. This event is ADA accessible and drop-offs are permitted adjacent to the registration desk prior to parking at MHCC. Please keep in mind that no pets, outside food, beverages or coolers are allowed.
