Dr. Tsan graduated the Beijing Graduate School of China Academy of Chinese Medical Sciences, and he represents the most traditional approach to acupuncture.

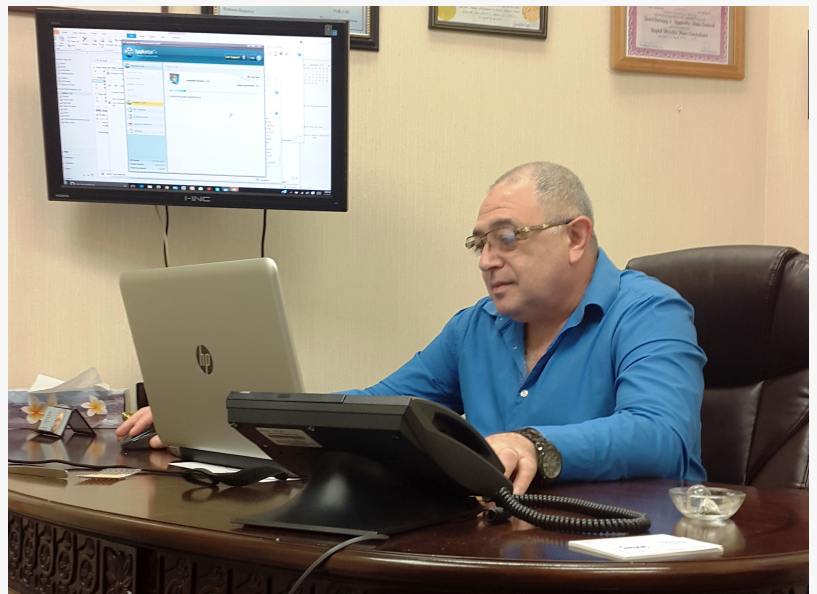

Western practitioners could not heal. After US Congress had permitted the sale of the herbal formulas without FDA approval, the official use of those medicines significantly soared. The growing recognition of the acupuncture resulted from a decision of some major healthcare insurance companies to fully or partially cover these treatments in some states, such as California, New Jersey, New-York, Florida, doctor Tsan said. Growing number of major US hospitals and clinics such as Johns Hopkins Hospital, Mayo Clinic, and at the University of Maryland Medical Center, have opened integrative medicine departments that take along Western and Oriental methodologies to healthcare.



Studies indicate that the quantity of US residents ready to undergo the acupuncture treatments continues to grow. Based on the survey performed by the US Government, more than one-third of grownups and approximately 15% of youngsters in the USA underwent different treatment
