However, certain challenges faced by cold chain vendors in emerging economies like the lack of proper infrastructure, the presence of minimal logistic support, lack of proper warehousing facilities, limited presence of service providers, and lack of skilled workers have led to substantial wastage of food products in these countries. Proper cold storage facilities and cold chain logistics can reduce the food wastage and health related issues in this emerging economies."

According to the report, a key growth driver is the need to reduce food wastage. According to the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and World Resources Institute (WRI), about one-third of the food produced every year is wasted. Fruits and vegetables are products that are wasted the most; about 25% of them are wasted at the production level. In addition, perishable food products are often exposed to fluctuating temperatures during transit and handling, which adds to the wastage. The global population is expected to increase at a rapid pace in the future, which is expected to increase the demand for food products.
