

Will FreedomFest Catapult Libertarian Presidential Candidate Gary Johnson to the Main Stage?

LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, UNITED STATES, July 11, 2016 /EINPresswire.com/ -- Political junkies and skeptics are still scratching their heads, wondering "How did this happen? How did Donald Trump take over the Republican Party?" Trump spoke to a standing room only audience Saturday, July 11. Yes, it was 7-11 in Vegas. And it was Trump's lucky day. His appearance attracted major media coverage. Trump's poll numbers rose sharply right after his appearance at FreedomFest and he dominated the Primaries thereafter. Will Gary Johnson experience a rise in the polls in the same fashion as Trump did after his appearance at FreedomFest?
