

Airbus Defence and Space showcase the aerial refuelling (AAR) kit for its C-295 light tactical transport aircraft

This year's event will provide an overview of strategic and tactical airlifts in Europe with topics addressed by major militaries and multinational commands.

FLORENCE, ITALY, July 25, 2016 /EINPresswire.com/ -- At this year's Farnborough Air Show, Airbus Defence and Space showcased the <u>aerial refuelling (AAR)</u> kit for its C-295 light tactical transport aircraft. Using a hose-and-drogue system, the AAR kit for the C-295 configures the transport to serve as a low-speed tanker for helicopters, drones and turboprops. The fuel is drawn from the C-295's main fuel tanks, but the customer can opt for auxiliary tanks. The modification process of adding the AAR kit is 'minimal.' The AAR-equipped C-295 can also function as a forward refuelling station on the ground.
