Then, blood starts accumulating in the veins. Eventually, the accumulated blood causes the vein to 'varicose' and forms varicocele.

It is important to understand that diseases like these can crop up due to a sedentary lifestyle. This basically means that the lifestyle being followed is more susceptible to getting acquired diseases. The reason for which is, if you don't have an active lifestyle, the immune system also becomes less able to deal with what may come. A healthy balance must thus be maintained between nutrition, exercise, and remedies so that a successful cure is obtained. Only that will lead to the overall improvement in the health with minimal chances of recurring of the condition.
