

ENT Devices Global Market Projected to Reach \$14,785 million and Growing at a CAGR of 7.2% From 2016 to 2022

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According to Stratistics MRC, "ENT devices market is expected to grow from \$9,100 million in 2015 to \$14,785 million by 2022 at a CAGR of 7.2%." The major factors impacting ENT device market growth are increasing aging population and related disorders such as lower functioning levels of ear, nose, & throat and hearing loss. In addition, technological advancements, rising occurrence of chronic sinusitis, increasing adoption of minimally invasive ENT procedures and increasing disposable income levels are fueling the growth of global ENT devices market. However limited battery life, stringent reimbursement policy, lack of skilled professionals and high costs of ENT devices are the factors hampering the market growth.

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By product, hearing implants segment is expected to witness high growth rate during the forecast period. Hearing aids segment is likely to acquire the largest market share on account of rapidly increasing advanced and user friendly devices. North America is anticipated to be the largest market while, Asia Pacific is projected to grow at a faster pace. The growth of this region is attributed to rising levels of disposable income, presence of target disease people and increasing demand for ENT devices from the emerging regions such as China, Japan and India.
