

Bend Brewfest Coming Up in Bend, Oregon at the Les Schwab Amphitheater

Annual beer festival returns featuring a growing number of breweries

BEND, OREGON, USA, August 9, 2016 /EINPresswire.com/ -- [Bend Brewfest](#) returns for its 14th year to the [Les Schwab Amphitheater](#) along the Deschutes River in Bend, Oregon's Old Mill District. This year's three-day festival will run from Thursday, August 18 through Saturday, August 20, and will feature 75 participating breweries and cideries pouring 190 tasty craft beverages. Every year the Brewfest runs a waiting list of over 30 breweries seeking entry to the second largest Brewfest in the State of Oregon.



As always, the Bend Brewfest focuses on tasting and enjoying fine regional craft beers as well as great food – all while raising money for local nonprofits, the Deschutes River Conservancy and NeighborImpact. A crowd favorite, the coveted “X-Tap” is back, which features specialty, very low production beers from a variety of brewers.
