Background bridges are engaging roadmaps to what we have in common, Spiegel explains.

Another trend we all have in common: phones with cameras and photos.

In today's modern tech world people carry cameras and virtual photo albums right in their pocket. Whether it's showcasing pictures of your family or your pet, or taking a selfie of you and your new friend, modern phones bring a deeper dimension to conversations and connections.

Jill suggests giving sincere compliments with each selfie, "Look at your vibrant smile, you radiate sunshine." One comment, one conversation can be the exact words someone needs to hear at just the right time, says Spiegel. "There is am opportunity and lesson in every encounter."
