

NADIA DEAN presents CAMERON at Rooted in the Mountains Symposium

Award-winning docudrama based on A Demand of Blood: The Cherokee War of 1776

to the Cherokees, and duty to his conscience, Cameron sinks deeper into turmoil, as he realizes his noble attempts to save innocent women and children have become his undoing.
