invasive heart surgery, I want the opportunity to help heal those hearts with my lifestyle modification and disease-prevention program. I give to the community because too many people are ill and in need of the services we offer."

The patent-pending Sara Soulati Health for Life Program is a lifestyle modification and reversal of disease and prevention program offered exclusively at the physician practices of Global Cardio Care Centers and Global Cardio Care—West Los Angeles. It is combined with Enhanced External Counterpulsation (EECP®), a non-surgical, FDA-cleared therapy to address cardiovascular disease and related illness.

- Transportation. Soulati operates three-to-four drivers and a fleet of passenger vans daily to assist church families and the community with dependable transportation to and from appointments in Inglewood and West Los Angeles. Global Cardio Care, Inc. has documented 78,700 rides in 13 years.
- Health Screenings. Church families are invited to get free health screenings at special events by Global Cardio Care, and over 13 years, the team has delivered 28, 700 complimentary health screenings for blood pressure, cholesterol and blood glucose.
- EECP Therapy. For people without ability to pay for EECP therapy, Soulati donates complimentary EECP treatment.

EECP therapy is considered for cardiovascular disease, end-stage of life, complications from stroke, congestive heart failure, diabetes, peripheral vascular disease, and other related illness. Since 2002, more than 25,600 free hours of EECP have been donated to the community.

• Sara Soulati Health for Life Program. During EECP therapy, each guest regardless of his or her ability to pay receives one-to-one lifestyle health coaching with instant feedback at bedside for one hour daily in addition to a full educational program about plant-based nutrition and exercise. Since the program's inception, Soulati has donated 250,400 hours to help screen, educate, and treat people to understand cardiovascular disease.
