He was earlier Non-Executive Chairman of Sustainable Forest Holdings Ltd, a Hong Kong-based publicly held sustainable forest management firm. He was also a founder of merchant banks GlobalNet Venture Partners, Buckingham Partners and BAII (Asia) Limited. He spent numerous years in a range of senior management positions in the United States, Latin America and Asia with Chemical Bank (JPMorgan Chase) and HSBC. Mr. Banigan is a graduate of the Edmund A. Walsh School of Foreign Service, Georgetown University with a B.S. in International Economics. Verdant Power, established in 2000 and headquartered in New York, NY, is an early stage technology provider of integrated renewable energy systems, using marine hydrokinetic (MHK) energy services and technologies. The company's underwater turbine systems convert the kinetic energy of tidal and river water currents into electrical and mechanical power. Verdant Power has successfully demonstrated the operations of its systems in NYC's East River adjacent to Roosevelt Island. This demonstration project is the first grid- connected array of tidal energy turbines in the world and is a recipient of the first-ever commercial license for MHK energy generation in the U.S. The company is undertaking to replicate its NYC project in Canada, Ireland, and the UK while advancing its technology.
